



Miss S's 4K Preschool Supplies List for 2022-23

Please Provide the Following:

School Uniforms – we will strictly adhere to the school handbook; khaki, navy, red, white, and black are the colors allowed for pants (child is able to zip, snap, and pull up independently), shorts, skirts, skorts, leggings, dresses, and shirts.

School Uniform:

- Khaki, navy, red, white, black pants, skirts, skorts, jumpers, shorts, dresses (please teach your child to zip, snap, and pull up clothes independently)
- Solid colored shirts are navy, red, white, or black
- Shorts or leggings are worn under skirts, jumpers, dresses (please teach your child how to put on and take off leggings)
- Closed toed shoes
- Blue or red jacket (pullovers are difficult for them to put on and take off)

- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 4 containers of baby wipes
- 1 spray bottle of sunscreen
- Earthquake Kit

Please Label the Following:

- 1 Sports refillable water bottle, no glass 
- Rest Time Materials (only ¾ time or full time students)
 - * Rollee Pollee (<http://rolleepollee.com>) – To save space and ease in cleaning up, we ask for Rollee Pollee which is a blanket and pillow combination (**better for all ages**)
 - * If a Rollee Pollee is not desired, please send a crib sheet, crib sized blanket, and an **airplane** sized pillow (**easier for 4's than for 3.5's**) 
- 2 boxes of Crayola markers, 8 or 10 count box 
- 2 boxes of Crayola watercolor paint 
- 1 gallon Ziploc bag for your child for change of clothes. Label with name on clothing and bag: 2 pairs of underwear, 2 pants/shorts/skorts, 2 shirt, 2 pairs of socks. 
- Lunch box –Practice with your child how to open and close lunch box, small boxes inside, FOR SAFETY no glass containers
- 4 boxes of Crayola crayons, 24 crayons box 
- 8 little glue sticks 
- Rounded Fiskar (best economical choice, consistently works) scissors (no cover needed)
- Please NO backpacks! A teacher is providing a tote bag for each student.
